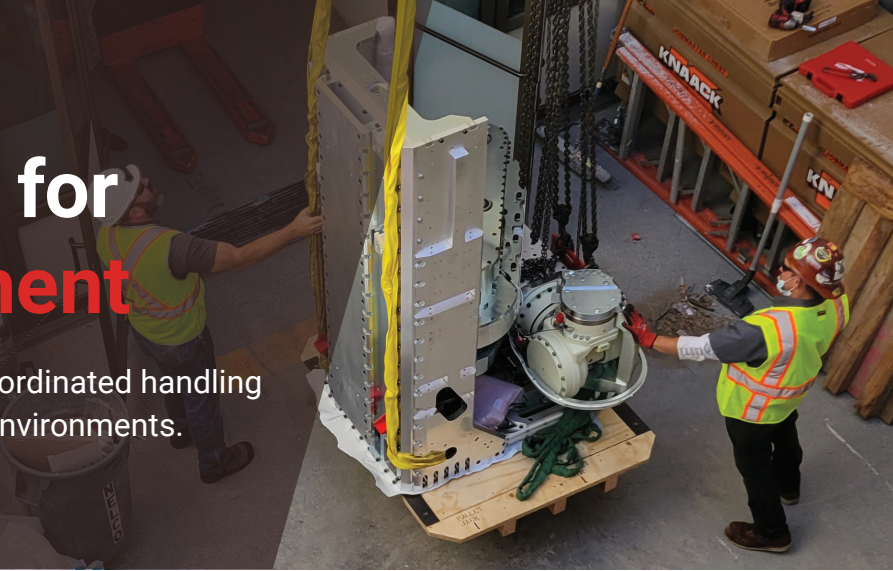

3

Transportation Coordination:

4

Placement Execution:

Controlled unloading, lifting, positioning, and final placement.

5

Completion:

Final verification and closeout documentation.
